Are microwaves available?

Microwaves are available in classrooms. Students have 20 minutes to eat their lunches. In order to allow all students to have the opportunity to have a heated lunch, we will be limiting the heat time for students to around 1 min. Do not send food that has to be cooked as there is not enough time to allow everyone to eat if students are cooking food. Please read labels carefully. Thermos containers are a great option for hot food.

Can my child bring toys to school?

We do not encourage students to bring toys except for special days, as we are concerned about them going missing ,being broken, or acting as a distraction. Students may bring toys for recess with your permission with the understanding that this is an extra responsibility that will fall on students and not teachers. Also, if the toy becomes a distraction for a child even when it is in the backpack or acting as a problem in a different way, she/he will be asked not to bring toys.

Can my child come to school if he/she is ill?

Students should stay home and away from others when they have symptoms of respiratory illness. The symptoms could be due to influenza, RSV, COVID-19, or other respiratory viruses. Please see the AHS guidelines and recommendations.
